The Panchayati Raj System is the local self government in India. It was introduced by a Constitutional Amendment in 1992. The word 'Raj' means rule and 'Panchayat' means assembly of five. The Panchayati Raj System is a process through which people participate in their own government.

Women play an important role in the Panchayati Raj System. In 1993, 33% seats in the Panchayats were reserved for women. It was one of the important steps taken towards the empowerment of women. In 2009, Central Government increased the reservation from 33% to 50%.
