Japan is an island country in East Asia. It is made up of over 6,800 islands stretching from Hokkaido in the north to Kyushu, and Shikoku which make up about 97% of Japan's land area. Mountains cover about 70% of the country's terrain. Japan has a popullation of over 126 million people and has a highly developed focused on manufacturing. The official language is Japanese and the main religions practiced are Shintoism and Buddhism. Japan has amazing cultures and traditions. It is a Japanese custom to wear a yukata (summer kimono) and dance to the rhythm of taiko drums during the Bon Odori Festival held in the summer. When a Japanese baby is born, the ceremony is held in the Shinto shrine and when someone dies the ceremony takes place in a Buddhist temple.Other than this there are several festivals celebrated in Japan. 47 Japanese prefectures has a different festival which

usually takes place in the summer. Locals usually participate in these festivals by wearing a yukata and sandals. The most famous Japanese festivals are:

- 1.Gion Festival in Kyoto- The largest parade in Japan which started in the 800's when there was an epidemic similar to the Coronavirus.
- 2. Awa Odori Festival in Tokushima- A Dance festival held during the Obon-Week (the week when the spirits of the deceased are believed to visit the world).
- 3.Nebuta Festival in Aomori- A festival dedicated to ancient warriors in Northern Japan.

Japan's streets, roads,tourist places and convenience stores are extremely clean and hygiene. It's no secret that Japan's villages are among the most beautiful in the world and offer a unique insight into traditional Japanese life. Japan's villages offer a wonderful contrast to its spectacular cities.
